Reported Speech Worksheet

Explanation of Reported Speech

Use reported speech (also known as indirect speech) to describe what someone said without quoting their exact words.

Note: You may need to change the tense, pronouns, time expressions, etc.

Rules for Changing Tense

- Present Simple → Past Simple
 - o Direct: "I like coffee," she said.
 - o Reported: She said (that) she **liked** coffee.
- Present Continuous → Past Continuous
 - o Direct: "I am studying," he said.
 - o Reported: He said (that) he was studying.
- Present Perfect \rightarrow Past Perfect
 - o Direct: "I have finished," they said.
 - o Reported: They said (that) they had finished.
- Past Simple \rightarrow Past Perfect
 - o Direct: "I visited Amsterdam," she said.
 - o Reported: She said (that) she **had visited** Amsterdam.

Changing Pronouns

• "I" becomes he/she/they, "we" becomes they, etc.

Changing Time Expressions

- "now" \rightarrow "then"
- "today" \rightarrow "that day"
- "tomorrow" \rightarrow "the next day"
- "yesterday" \rightarrow "the day before"
- etc.

Reporting Questions

- Yes/No questions are introduced with *if* or *whether*.
 - o Direct: "Do you like coffee?" she asked.
 - Reported: She asked if I liked coffee.
- WH-questions keep the question word.
 - o Direct: "Where do you live?" he asked.
 - Reported: He asked where I lived.

Reporting Imperatives

• Use *to* + verb for **positive commands**

1. "I'm going to the store," he said.

- Use *not to* + verb for **negative commands**
 - o Direct: "Close the door," he said.
 - Reported: He told me **to close** the door.
 - o Direct: "Don't be late," she said.
 - Reported: She told me **not to be** late.
