Passive Voice

Explanation of the Passive Voice

- o Use the passive voice to focus on the action rather than the subject.
- o In passive sentences, the object of an active sentence becomes the subject.
- o Form the passive voice with the verb "to be" in the appropriate tense, followed by the past participle of the main verb.

Structure

- Active Voice: Subject + Verb + Object
 - o Example: The teacher (subject) teaches (verb) the lesson (object).
- Passive Voice: Object + "to be" + Past Participle + (by + Subject)
 - o Example: The lesson (subject) is taught (verb) by the teacher (object).

Examples

Present Simple:

- Active: They make cars in Asia.
- Passive: Cars are made in Asia.

Past Simple:

- Active: I wrote the story.
- Passive: The story was written by me.

Present Continuous:

- Active: The company is building a new apartment building.
- Passive: A new apartment building is being built.

Past Continuous:

- Active: He was tidying up the living room.
- Passive: The living room was being tidied up.

Present Perfect:

- Active: They have finished the film.
- Passive: The film has been finished.

Past Perfect:

- Active: She had completed her homework.
- Passive: Her homework had been completed.

Future Simple:

Active: They will deliver the package. Passive: The package will be delivered.
