



Present Perfect Worksheet

Explanation of the Present Perfect

- Use the present perfect to describe actions or events that have occurred at some point in the past but are relevant to the present moment
- Also use it to express experiences or accomplishments that are connected to the present.

Structure

- **Affirmative:** Subject + **have/has** + past participle
 - Example: *She **has visited** Madrid.*
- **Negative:** Subject + **have/has not** + past participle
 - Example: *They **haven't finished** their school work.*
- **Interrogative:** **Have/Has** + subject + past participle?
 - Example: ***Have** you **seen** this film?*

Use It in These Ways

1. **Unspecified Time in the Past:**
 - Example: *I have eaten paella before.*
2. **Life Experiences:**
 - Example: *He has traveled to China.*
3. **Recent Actions with Present Relevance:**
 - Example: *She has just left the office.*
4. **Achievements:**
 - Example: *They have won three championships.*
5. **Ongoing Situations:**
 - Example: *We have worked here for three years.*
